ots of people feel anxious or depressed in this world that we live in. They feel as if there is nothing around them that is good, they are being attacked constantly, or things won't get better. Maybe you can fill in the blanks with how it is that you feel that falls into those categories of anxious or depressed. There are biological reasons for these feelings but there is also a spiritual malady going on too.

Perhaps it's ok to feel these ways. If you think about what is going on in the spiritual battle all around you, maybe anxiety and depression make sense. The devil is prowling around like a roaring lion seeking to devour you. He is seeking your

eternal death. Doesn't it make sense that you would be anxious about that? Sure, it does.

When you look around you see problems with no solutions. You see sin with no repentance. Wouldn't it make sense to get despondent about a terrible situation all around you? Sure. The devil is at work in this world and in

other people. And more often than not, it seems like he is winning.

What's the answer to what we experience and see? Well, it might be easy to say you should be anxious or depressed. But that isn't an answer we can abide by forever. For we know another truth as well. The Lord Jesus endured the agony and death of sin. Whereas the devil has rebelled against God, Jesus remained faithful to the task that his heavenly Father had given to him.

Jesus lays down his life on that cross and rests in the tomb. On the Third Day he breaks forth from the grave and from death. This is the answer that we need when we feel overwhelmed. When we're drowning, Jesus has risen above all that would pull

us down under the water. Jesus lives and the victory has been won.

Since he lives, never to die again, we have life in his name. You belong to him and his resurrection life is yours. The answer to anxiety or depression is the resurrection of Jesus Christ. Even when all seemed lost, Jesus won. The same is true for you. Even if all seems lost, remember that Jesus rose from the grave for you.

Don't let the accusations of Satan have more power over you than the truth of what Jesus has done for you. There is no reason to give up when Jesus hasn't given up on you.

He has given you his Holy Spirit and you are a

temple of that Spirit. You are a testament to the love that Jesus has for all people. Because of the life vou have: as broken as it may be; Jesus loves you with a living, resurrection love.

The spiritual battle for your soul is real. And I know how it turns out. Romans 8 says, "What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare his

own Son but gave him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things?...Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword?...No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord."

Iesus has won and we turn to him when the world is dark because he is the light of the world. In Christ.


